I have changed the pin box bolt pattern to match after market air bag and side winder pin boxes. This will give you more flexibility for different tow vehicles.







The lift jacks have had an upgrade to a model that folds itself up after it retracts.

These jacks are able to be mounted on the outer most point of the front of the chassis to give more stability.





This picture shows the rear jacks have been moved forward to give more ground clearance at the back of the chassis. Note the smooth aerodynamics of the under body.







The jacks are hooked up to a self leveling control system with a remote control. I will do some testing on this before I make it a standard feature.

Pressing one button to level the Adventura would be a very cool feature.



We have fitted a new bed lift system to make it easy to use the under bed storage.







This client has chosen a more Australian timber look for his furniture. The below images show the new drawer design for the wardrobe drawers and the panty drawers. The six pull out drawer pantry will give you much more space in the kitchen. Note that the pantry does have doors.
